HOOSIER HOSPITAL PRICING MEETINGS

During the 2021 Legislative Session, the Indiana General Assembly passed Senate Enrolled Act 325, which requires certain nonprofit hospitals in Indiana to hold an annual public forum for the purposes of: (1) obtaining feedback from the community about the nonprofit hospital's performance in the previous year; (2) discussing the pricing of health services provided at the nonprofit hospital; and (3) discussing the contributions made by the nonprofit hospital to the community.
