Review the applicability

Check for duplicative monitoring and request removal

- Stack testing your limits

May not be required depending on necessary control efficiency

- Know your definitions

PM (particulate matter) = PM-100

- Take inventory of all of your insignificant activities

Verifies your permitting level

Informs inspectors that units have been accounted for

- Keep an eye on industry “watch lists”

Internal combustion engines (RICE) --- wastewater utilities, call banks

Industrial laundering facilities

Incineration (updates to the CISWI rules) --- burn-off ovens, certain boilers, chip dryers?

- Other items
